The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary

In 1954 Pope Pius XII declared a feast day honoring Mary as Queen of heaven and earth. But “queen” is one of the oldest titles given to Mary in Christian tradition. When Elizabeth spoke of Mary as “the mother of my Lord” (Luke 1.43), she used the words that mean “queen mother” in the Old Testament.

Jesus is the Lord and King of heaven and earth. So Mary who was chosen by the Father, was filled with the Holy Spirit, and became the mother of Christ, can be considered queen. Like a queen, she stood at the cross on Calvary, supporting her kingly Son's sacrifice with her love, faith, and obedience.

After being raised body and soul to heaven, Mary now sits in splendor at the right hand of her Son. There she intercedes for us. We ponder this whenever we pray the Fifth Glorious Mystery of the Rosary, Mary's coronation as Queen of Heaven.

Mary's power as queen is manifested in the tenderness of a loving mother who cares for her children. Saint Bernard of Clairvaux (feast August 20), who had a great devotion to Mary, often wrote books and sermons that inspired his listeners to turn to her. For example:

In dangers, in doubts, in difficulties, think of Mary, call upon Mary...with her for guide, you shall never go astray; while invoking her, you shall never lose heart; so long as she is in your mind, you are saved from deception; while she holds your hand, you cannot fall; under her protection you have nothing to fear...

Artists depict Mary being crowned by her Son, or sometimes by God the Father. In either case, as Mother of the King of Kings and by her role in redemption, Mary is Queen of the Universe.
